

Screening Tests Necessary for Proper Patient Care

At Family Eyecare of Roswell, we are committed to providing you with the latest technology and advanced diagnostic tools available in the eye industry. Much like a dentist takes an X-ray of the mouth on a regular basis, we perform **High definition OCT Imaging, Digital Retinal Photography, Visual Field Screening, Corneal Topography**, as well as other advanced tests. These provide us with enhanced understanding, better documentation, and proper illustration or monitoring of the parameters and health of your eyes.

The screening tests below are available for \$35 per test.

1. **High Definition OCT imaging**: OCT imaging utilizes laser scanning technology to reveal early signs of diseases in the optic nerve and retina. Many conditions such as Macular Degeneration, Diabetic Retinopathy and Glaucoma can be diagnosed early by scanning the retinal and optical nerve fiber layers located in the back of the eye.
2. **Baseline Digital Retinal Photography**: Digital pictures provide an accurate record of ocular tissues by giving us a detailed view of the external or internal structures of your eyes. Diseases such as Hypertensive Retinopathy, Corneal Dystrophy, Retinal Detachment and Ocular tumors of benign or malignant nature, can be detected using this screening method.
3. **FDT, Visual Field Screening**: A number of neurological conditions can manifest as loss of peripheral vision. Because this is not always noticeable to the person affected by those conditions, visual field screening is a reliable measure to detect any side vision loss as a result of an early neurological disease. Examples of those diseases are Pituitary Adenoma, Meningioma, advanced Glaucoma, Retinal Detachment and Stroke.
4. **Corneal Topography**: A medical technique for mapping the surface curvature of the cornea, the outer structure of the eye. The three-dimensional map of the cornea is therefore a valuable aid to the doctor in the diagnosis and treatment of a number of conditions such as, Keratoconus, planning for LASIK and assessing the fit of specialty contact lenses.

If your health evaluation requires more in-depth testing due to a medical diagnosis, the fee schedule for each procedure is paid at the Usual & Customary rate and can be submitted to most medical insurance plans.

If you do not have a medical plan, all procedures are paid at the Usual & Customary rate.

Please remember that all insurance claims are subject to review by your insurance carrier and will be processed and paid once approved. If any procedures are denied by your insurance carrier, it becomes the patient's (or legal guardian's) responsibility to provide payment.
